

RECENT HISTORY HIGHLIGHTS

- 2003** The Rev. Dick Gilchrist retires after 13 years of service
- 2004** “Restore and Renew” campaign finances the updating of Church interior
- 2005** The parish calls The Rev. Mark Delcuze as rector
- 2006** Asphalt roof replaced on and refurbished kitchen installed in rectory
- 2008** Exterior stripping and painting and historical restoration and refurbishment of porches on rectory
- 2010** The Rev. Mark Delcuze leaves
- 2011-13** “Raise the Roof” campaign to replace North Hall, South Hall and Sanctuary roofs
- 2012** The parish calls The Rev. Whitney Altopp as rector
- 2013** Boiler/Natural Gas conversion: North Hall
- 2014** Attic Insulation installed: North Hall
- 2015** Steeple restored and exterior stonework and exterior painting completed: Church
- 2016** Built Samaritan Garden to address hunger
- 2017** Created new Mission and Vision Statements and Legacy Society (Planned Giving Program)
- 2018** “Financial Sustainability” Task Force commissioned. A purpose-focused effort to align our staffing and infrastructure with the expected future resources of the church.
- 2019-20** Sale of South Hall and Pound Street, campus parking reconfiguration, and major staff changes
- 2021** Insulation installed in steeple and converted the boiler to natural gas in the sanctuary
- 2023** Hiring of full-time minister for Youth and Families from set-aside funds (from sale of property)

Identified building needs

- Church
 - Main exterior and stonework painting and power washing
 - Refurbish and paint interior
 - Narthex insulation
- Rectory
 - Refurbish rectory porches
 - Chimney repair
 - Refurbish interior rooms: kitchen and bathrooms
- North Hall
 - Refurbish kitchen
 - Replace/upgrade existing A/C
 - Replace flat roof
- Meeting Barn
 - Replace roof
